Adelaide Airport

The Adelaide Airport is located approximately six kilometers west of Adelaide's city centre. Upon arrival, you will walk across an aero-bridge to the inbound passenger area. Baggage Trolleys are free of charge.

The new state of the art multi user passenger terminal received its first official flight, Malaysia Airlines on 15 Oct 05. The terminal offers 33 retail outlets including food and beverage, duty free and specialty shops.

You also have access to the Internet and currency exchange outlets, Automatic Teller Machines (ATM), restrooms and other facilities in the terminal.

Transportation

Taxi

There are taxi bays outside the terminal. A taxi journey from the Adelaide airport to the city centre takes approximately 10 to 15 minutes.

Airport Bus

Sky link Adelaide offers a regular service between Adelaide airport, the National Rail Terminal, Adelaide city centre and hotels. A one-way journey is approximately 25 to 30 minutes.

Hire Car

Several hire car companies operate from the Adelaide Airport. The information and booking desks located within both the terminals.
